

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1(Passed on 15th day of April 2026)

Read over the record and documents. It has been pending for a long time. Accused No.3 absent. Non bailable warrants were issued against accused No.3 on several times, however his presence could not be secured. As a result, there are sufficient grounds to conclude that the accused No.3 absconded or is intentionally concealing himself so that an arrest order would not be executed. **Section 82 of the Cr.P.C.** provides that there is no other option than to proclaim. Furthermore, given the preceding discussion and the age of the matter, I believe that the proclamation must be made under **Section 82 of the Cr.P.C.** As a result, I am inclined to proclaim the accused No.3 and show cause notice to the surety of the accused No.3 to appear and why the amount of bond made by him for the accused No.3 should not be forfeited and recovered from him. As a result, the following order is passed:

ORDER

1.	Issue proclamation under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. against accused No.3.
2.	Police Station Officer of the Manchar police station is directed as per Section 82(2)(i) (a) Cr.P.C. to publicly read the proclamation in some conspicuous place of the town or village in which the accused No.3 ordinarily resides, and as per section 82(2)(i)(b) Cr.P.C. to affix

	the proclamation to some conspicuous part of the house or homestead in which accused No.3 ordinarily resides or to some conspicuous place of his town or village.
3.	Police Station Officer of the concern police station is also directed to prepare a detailed panchanama regarding the compliance of execution of this proclamation and submit the same in the Court.
4.	Police Station Officer of police station concern is also directed to collect the necessary particulars of movable and immovable properties belonging to accused No.3.
5.	Assistant Superintendent of the Court is also directed to affix the copy of the proclamation to the conspicuous part of the Court-house or notice board of the Court, as per section 82(2)(i)(c) of Cr.P.C.
6.	Copy of this order be sent to the Police Inspector of Police Station concern for its efficient and expedite compliance.
7.	Issue show-cause notice to the surety of the accused No.3.
