State of Maharashtra Vs. Vaibhav Shantaram Gaikar

ORDER BELOW EXH. 73.
(Passed on 25.03.2026)

01. By way of this application accused **Vaibhav Shantaram Gayakar** has prayed for grant of permission to travel abroad within the period of 28.03.2026 to 05.04.2026. As per the accused he wants to go Vietnam for business work. But, due to pendency of the present criminal case, he is not able to travel abroad without permission of this Court. Smt. N. M. Sherkar advocate for the accused submitted that, the accused has furnished surety and he is ready to face the trail. The accused is ready to abide all terms and he will not breach bail conditions imposed by Court. He will not misuse the liberty.

02. A. P. P. opposed the application on ground that, the case under section 304-A IPC is pending against accused. No documents are submitted by applicant regarding the visit to the mentioned Country. Accused may flee from justice and will not present at the time of trial, if permitted. He prayed to reject the application.

03. Perused the record. The accused is charge sheeted for the offences punishable under section 304-A of the Indian Penal Code. The accused furnished bail. Hence, his presence is already secured. The charged is also framed and evidence of some witnesses is recorded. Advocate of the accused is ready to conduct the trail in his absence. Hence, there is no hurdle in granting the permission to travel abroad within the period of 28.03.2026 to 05.04.2026. Hence, I pass following order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The accused **Vaibhav Shantaram Gayakar** is permitted to travel abroad (Vietnam) in between 28.03.2026 to 05.04.2026 for business work.
