Advocate for the accused submitted that in view of judgment pronounced by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in Ramesh Kumar Vs The State of NCT of Delhi, Criminal Appeal No._____ of 2023. (Arising out of SLP (Crl.) No 2358 of 2023) pronounced on 4th July, 2023, the condition imposed by this court may be relaxed.
05. I have gone through entire judgment of Hon'ble the Apex Court said judgment is in respect of Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for Anticipatory Bail. Therefore, the said judgment is not applicable to the case at hand.
06. Moreover, in the case at hand, these accused have their active participation in the alleged crime, as well as specific record of money transaction in the bank account of their names. Therefore, they are not entitled to get relaxed the condition as they prayed. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:-
