ORDER BELOW EXH.5
(Passed on this 1st June, 2026)

1- The applicants are seeking interim protection in Crime no. 138/2026 registered with the Alephata police station for offence under Section 115(2), 118(1), 352, 351(2), 351(3) read with section 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (in short BNS) .

2- Ld. Advocate Shri. S. D. Kokane submitted that there are cross FIRs out of the same incident. In the present case, the applicant no. 1 is a Government servant and was on duty on the date of incident. He has filed attendance certificate from his department supporting his attendance. Applicant no. 2 is the wife of the informant. There are matrimonial disputes between her and the informant. At this stage, there appears force in the submission of Ld. Advocate for the applicants that the applicants are falsely implicated. The cross FIR shows that applicant no. 2 has also suffered injuries and applicant no. 1 was not present at the spot.

3- In view of the above, the applicants deserve interim protection till disposal of their main application. Hence, the following order-

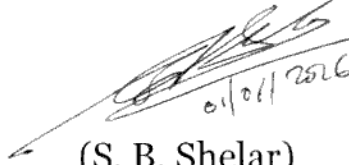
ORDER

- 1] In the event of arrest of the applicants, they shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail on furnishing

PR. and S.B. of Rs. 25,000/- each till the disposal of the main application.

- 2] The applicants shall attend the concerned police station on 3rd and 4th June, 2026 between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.
- 3] Applicants shall not tamper with prosecution witnesses, in any manner.
- 4] Inform concerned police station accordingly.
