

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

(State of Maharashtra V/s. Kailash Hiram)

Today, the Ld. APP and Ld. Advocate Shri. R. R. Bhagat for the accused heard on the point of framing charge. The Ld. APP has submitted that there is ample direct material in the charge-sheet to frame charges against the accused.

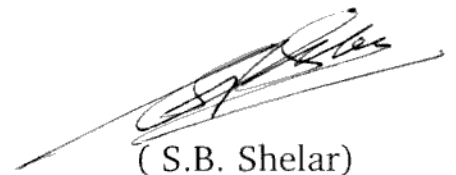
2] Per contra, the Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the the accused is falsely implicated. There is no iota of evidence in the charge-sheet to substantiate the charges leveled against the accused.

3] Perusal of the charge-sheet shows that the FIR was promptly registered. There are statements of witnesses which prima facie support the case of the prosecution. Hence, at this stage, there is ample material to frame charge against the accused. Hence, order:

ORDER

Charge be framed against the accused under sections 302 of the Indian Penal Code.
