**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1] The applicant **Abhijit Chandrakant Pawar** has filed this application as per Sec. 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of bail in respect of Crime No. 27 of 2026 registered with Ranjangaon MIDC Police Station for the offenses punishable U/Sec. 309(4) r/w. 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023.

2] It is contention of applicant that he is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present crime. He has not committed any offence. Applicant is in jail since date of arrest. The FIR is against unknown person and applicant has been added subsequently during investigation without any strong or reliable evidence. There is no recovery pending. Investigation is almost completed. The applicant is not habitual offender.

3] The prosecution filed reply and opposed this application on the grounds that mobile was recovered from custody of the present applicant. The offence is serious in nature. If he release on bail then he will tamper the prosecution evidence and as he is residence of other district therefore, possibility of abscond can not be ruled out. The applicant is habitual offender and other crime registered on him.

4] Heard both the sides, perused investigation papers.

5] On perusal of the allegations made in FIR it appears that initially crime was registered against three unknown persons. The custody of applicant was sought by seeking production warrant from other crime bearing No. 25/2026, registered with same police station. The mobile handset and vehicle used while committing crime came to be recovered during investigation of the said other crime. The alleged offences are triable by the court of Judicial Magistrate First Class and not punishable with imprisonment more than 10 years. In such circumstances applicant can be released on bail by imposing stringent conditions in order to rule out possibility of tampering the witnesses and absconding of applicant and coming in contact with absconding accused, on the part of the applicant. Hence, I passed the following order -

**ORDER**

- 1) The application filed by applicant **Abhijit Chandrakant Pawar**, for grant of bail in respect of Crime No. 27 of 2026 registered with Ranjangaon MIDC Police

Station for the offenses punishable U/Sec. 309(4) r/w. 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 is allowed.

- 2) The applicant be released on bail on execution on his P. R. of Rs. 30,000/- with one or two sureties in the like amount subject to following conditions-
  - i) The applicant shall remain present at Ranjangaon MIDC Police Station in between 11.00 AM to 01.00 PM on first day of each month till conclusion of trial.
  - ii) He shall produce documents showing his photo identity, place of permanent residence, names of his family members and temporary address if any and name of the nearest Police Station within whose jurisdiction his permanent residence is situated at the time of furnishing bail.
  - iii) He shall not tamper prosecution witnesses.
  - iv) He shall produce his photo identity, contact number, and detail address

before the officer in-charge of the Police Station in whose jurisdiction his permanent residence is situated.

- 3) Bail before concerned Court.
- 4) Inform to the concern police station.
- 5) The Investigating Officer is directed to communicate the concerned Police Station in whose jurisdiction the applicant is permanently or temporarily residing about the registration of crime and copy of arrest panchanama of the applicant and submit report accordingly before the Trial Court.
