**ORDER BELOW EXH.10**

01. The accused Yogesh Sanjay Patil has filed this application for return of property under section 503 of the BNSS.

02. It is contended by the accused that, an offence vide C.R. No.89/2024 under Section 137(2), 64, 64(2)(i) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and under Sec.4, 8, 12 of The Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act, 2012 is registered against him. He is the owner of TVS Jupiter Classic (BSIV) DISC bearing registration No.MH-06/CB-2903 having Chassis No.MD626EG48K1E47343 and Engine No.EG4EK1831268, which is seized by police in the above offence. According to the accused, he is registered owner of the said vehicle which he requires for his daily use. The said vehicle is at Dadar Sagari Police Station and if it is kept unused, it will get damaged. Hence, it is prayed that the temporary custody of the said vehicle be given to him being a registered owner.

03. The Investigating Officer has filed say at Exh.12 and gave no objection to handover the custody of the vehicle to the accused on condition that he will not alienate or change the nature of the vehicle.

04. Heard both the sides and I have gone through the copy of certificate of registration produced by the accused.

05. Admittedly, a TVS Jupiter Classic (BSIV) DISC bearing registration No.MH-06/CB-2903 is seized during the investigation of C.R. No.89/2024 registered with Dadar Sagari Police Station. After investigation, the charge-sheet is filed and seized vehicle is lying in concerned Police Station.

06. The accused Yogesh Sanjay Patil has placed on record the copy of R.C. book of TVS Jupiter Classic (BSIV) DISC bearing registration No.MH-06/CB-2903. The document shows that, accused Yogesh Sanjay Patil is the registered owner of said vehicle.

07. The charge-sheet is filed and the matter is fixed for framing the charge. Thus, a time will require to decide the matter on merits. However, till then it is not desirable to keep the seized vehicle with the police in idle position as it will cause damage to the vehicle. The accused Yogesh Sanjay Patil is registered owner of the seized vehicle and therefore he is entitled for temporary custody of his vehicle on certain conditions. Hence, I pass following order -

**ORDER**

1. The application at Exh.10 is allowed.
2. The temporary custody of TVS Jupiter Classic (BSIV) DISC bearing registration No.MH-06/CB-2903 having Chassis No.MD626EG48K1E47343 and Engine No.EG4EK1831268, be given to the accused Yogesh Sanjay Patil on executing indemnity bond of Rs.75,000/- (Rs. Seventy Five Thousand only).
3. The accused shall not sale or alienate the vehicle or change the nature of the vehicle till the decision of the case on merit.
4. The Investigating Officer is directed to take the photographs of the vehicle and submit the said photographs in the proceeding.
5. The accused shall produce the vehicle as and when directed by the Court.
6. Inform to the concern Police Station.
