



ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MACP NRJ NO.22/2026

(Navya Vs. Shriram General Insurance Company Ltd.)

Heard the learned Advocate for the applicant. Perused the application, record and proceedings, the report of the Writ Section and the report submitted by the Finance Superintendent.

02. It appears from the record that in Motor Accident Claim Petition No.34/2011, compensation was awarded in favour of the applicants including minor applicants. As per the directions contained in the award, the shares of the minor applicants were directed to be deposited in fixed deposit accounts in a nationalized bank till they attained majority.

03. The record reveals that the share amount of Rs.2,00,000/- belonging to original applicant No.2 – Navya Nandakumar Nambiyar was deposited in Union Bank of India, Alibag Branch in Fixed Deposit Account No.540403030006512. The applicant has now placed on record that she has attained majority and is presently aged about 21 years and therefore she has become legally entitled to receive the said amount.

04. The report of the Writ Section further shows that no appeal or proceedings in respect of MACP No.34/2011 are pending before the Hon'ble High Court. The report of the Finance Section also confirms the deposit of the said amount.

05. Thus, there is no legal impediment in permitting the

withdrawal of the said amount. However, it is clarified that the present application pertains only to the share amount of original applicant No.2 – Navya Nandakumar Nambiyar and the deposits standing in the names of other applicants, namely Nikita Nandakumar Nambiyar and Kirti Nandakumar Nambiyar, shall remain intact and shall continue to be governed by the directions contained in the original award until appropriate orders are passed by this Court. Hence the following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The applicant Navya Nandakumar Nambiyar (Original Applicant No.2 in MACP No.34/2011) is permitted to withdraw the amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) along with accrued interest deposited in F.D. Account No.540403030006512 with Union Bank of India, Alibag Branch.
3. The Manager, Union Bank of India, Alibag Branch is directed to release the said amount along with accrued interest in favour of the applicant after due verification of her identity and completion of necessary bank formalities.
4. It is clarified that the fixed deposit amounts standing in the names of the other claimants, namely Nikita Nandakumar Nambiyar and Kirti Nandakumar Nambiyar, shall remain undisturbed and shall continue as per the

directions contained in the original award until further orders of this Court.

5. The Accounts/Finance Section of this Court shall issue necessary communication to the concerned bank for compliance of this order.
6. Miscellaneous Application stands disposed of accordingly.
