



ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MACP NRJ NO.28/2026

(Arun & Ors Vs. Reliance Gen.Ins. Com.Ltd.)

This is an application seeking withdrawal of compensation amount deposited in Court.

02. The applicants contend that pursuant to the judgment and award passed in MACP No.307/2016, the insurer has deposited Rs.28,29,992/- and Rs.2,55,497/- in this Tribunal. It is further contended that in First Appeal No. 1862 of 2025, the Hon'ble High Court, by order dated 30/01/2026 in Interim Application No.707 of 2026, has permitted the applicants to withdraw 50% of the deposited amount with accrued interest on usual undertaking. On that basis, the applicants seek release of the amount.

03. I have perused the application, the report of the Writ Section, the Finance report, and the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court.

04. The Writ Section report shows that First Appeal No. 1862 of 2025 along with connected interim applications is still pending before the Hon'ble High Court. Therefore, the entire deposited amount cannot be released at this stage.

05. However, the order dated 30/01/2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court clearly provides that the present applicants / original claimants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount deposited with accrued interest on usual

undertaking. The said order is binding on this Tribunal and is required to be implemented in its true letter and spirit.

06. The Finance report shows that the insurer has in fact deposited in this Tribunal a sum of Rs.28,29,992/- and Rs. 2,55,497/-, totaling Rs.30,85,489/-.

07. In view of the express permission granted by the Hon'ble High Court, the applicants are entitled to withdraw 50% of the total deposited amount together with proportionate accrued interest, subject to filing the usual undertaking before this Tribunal.

08. Since the appeal is still pending before the Hon'ble High Court, only such withdrawal as specifically permitted by the Hon'ble High Court can be allowed, and the remaining amount shall continue to remain in deposit subject to further orders. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

- 1.** The application is partly allowed.
- 2.** The applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the amount deposited in this Tribunal, along with proportionate accrued interest, in terms of the order dated 30/01/2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in First Appeal No. 1862 of 2025 with Interim Application No. 707 of 2026, on filing usual undertaking before this Tribunal.
- 3.** The remaining 50% amount with accrued interest shall remain deposited in this Tribunal till further orders of

the Hon'ble High Court or till final disposal of the appeal.

4. The Finance Section is directed to calculate the exact amount payable under the present order and, after verification of the undertaking and identity of the applicants, to disburse the said amount to the applicants by RTGS / account transfer in accordance with rules.
5. The application stands disposed of accordingly.
