



ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN MACP NRJ NO.49/2026

(Shikha & Ors Vs. Royal Sundaram General Insurance Com.)

By the present application, the applicants seek withdrawal of the balance compensation amount lying deposited in M.A.C.P No.305 of 2012.

2. Perused the application, report of the Writ Section and report submitted by the Superintendent, Finance Department.

3. It appears that by award dated 16.12.2016 passed in M.A.C.P No.305 of 2012, compensation came to be awarded in favour of the applicants. Pursuant thereto, the opponent-insurance company deposited an amount of Rs.34,76,540/- before this Tribunal on 10.04.2018.

4. Record further reveals that the insurance company preferred First Appeal No.1258 of 2017 before the Hon'ble Bombay High Court. During pendency of the appeal, an amount of Rs.12,00,000/- was permitted to be withdrawn by the applicants pursuant to the orders of the Hon'ble High Court and the said amount came to be disbursed equally amongst applicant Nos.1 to 3.

5. The report of the Writ Section shows that First Appeal No.1258 of 2017 along with connected Civil Application came to be finally decided by the Hon'ble High Court on 17.04.2026. The Hon'ble High Court dismissed the appeal preferred by the insurance company and specifically observed

that the original claimants are entitled to the compensation awarded by the Tribunal and are eligible to withdraw the same.

6. The report of the Superintendent, Finance Department further shows that after disbursement of Rs.12,00,000/-, the balance amount was kept in fixed deposit from time to time and as on today the amount available with accrued interest is Rs.35,90,450/-.

7. In view of dismissal of the appeal by the Hon'ble High Court and there being no subsisting stay operating against disbursement of the compensation amount, the applicants have become entitled to receive the balance amount lying deposited before this Tribunal. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

1. M.A.C.P. M.A. No.49 of 2026 is allowed.
2. Applicant Nos.1 to 3 are permitted to withdraw the balance compensation amount of Rs.35,90,450/- (Rupees Thirty Five Lakhs Ninety Thousand Four Hundred Fifty only) together with further accrued interest, if any, lying deposited in M.A.C.P. No.305 of 2012.
3. The Nazir/Finance Department shall transfer the said amount by RTGS/NEFT to the bank accounts of applicant Nos.1 to 3 in equal proportion, after due verification of their identity and bank particulars.
4. Necessary entries be taken and compliance

report be submitted.

5. M.A.C.P. M.A. No.49 of 2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
