The State of Maharashtra Vs. Aafsa Khan

ORDER BELOW EXH.1

Junior Engineer, Section Nandgaon, is present on behalf of the informant Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Ltd., Branch at Nandgaon, Tal. Murud, Dist. Raigad. Accused Aafsa Noor Mohammad Khan is represented through learned Advocate Shri C.C. Kamthe before the Panel of National Lok Adalat.

Learned Advocate for the accused submitted that the presence of the accused is secured through video conferencing by making video call from the handset of the learned Advocate. The identity of the accused was verified through video conferencing system to the satisfaction of the Court. The learned Advocate has signed on behalf of the accused under her instructions. Screenshot of the video conferencing interaction is attached herewith.

The learned Advocate for the accused has filed compromise pursis at Exh.14 contending that the matter has been amicably settled and the accused has paid electricity charges along with compounding charges under Section 152 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

The compromise pursis at Exh.14 is read over, recorded and accepted. In view of the settlement and compounding of offence, I proceed to pass the following order :-


ORDER

- 1] The offence punishable under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003 stands compounded under Section 152 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

- 2] The accused Aafsa Noor Mohammad Khan is acquitted for the offence punishable under Section 135 of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- 3] Bail bond of the accused stands cancelled and surety, if any, stands discharged.
- 4] Muddemal property i.e. black colour S.Q.M.M. 10 meter service wire be returned to the informant Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Ltd. after appeal period, if there is no legal impediment.
