Harsa Singh VS Gurbeer Singh

Present: Sh. Daljit Singh Sandhu, Advocate for the complainant.

Today, the case was fixed for presence of accused **Gurbeer Singh son of Baldev Singh** in pursuance of proclamation issued against him. Case called several times but accused **Gurbeer Singh son of Baldev Singh** did not put his appearance throughout the day.

Already statement of serving official **Ct. Sarabjeet Singh** has been recorded in this regard on 20.08.2024 in which he has stated that "I was directed by the Court to effect proclamation of accused namely **Gurbeer Singh son of Baldev Singh**. I was given four copies of the Proclamation warrants. In order to carry out the order of the Court:-

1. I have visited the house/shop/office of the accused on **19.08.2024** and
2. affixed one copy of the proclamation at the **main gate of the said house/shop/office** and
3. affixed second copy of the same at the common place i.e. **Sath/Chowk nearby the house/shop/office of the accused** where the accused is stated to be residing/working and
4. third copy has been affixed at **notice Board** of the court Complex.
5. I have publicly read the same **loudly at the Sath/Chowk** nearby the house/shop/office of the accused where the accused is stated to be residing/working.
6. Fourth copy of the proclamation is **Ex.PA** and same is produced before the Court and my report on the same is **Ex.PB**. I identify my signature on the same. The Statement is Correct".

I am satisfied from the statement of serving official and from the report **Ex.PB**, that the proclamation was duly published on the

specified day, in the manner specified in clause (i) of sub section (2) of section 82 CrPC.

Statutory period of 30 days fixed for presence of accused has elapsed. Therefore, accused **Gurbeer Singh son of Baldev Singh** is declared proclaimed person. Intimation to SHO concerned be given to make necessary entry in relevant register.

Counsel for the complainant suffered statement that preliminary evidence already recorded may kindly be read as part of evidence of complainant Under Section 335 BNSS and he also closed the evidence Under Section 335 BNSS on behalf of the complainant. He also stated that he will file separate application Under Section 85 BNSS if required. In view of the statement of counsel for the complainant, file be consigned to record room with liberty to complainant to file separate application Under Section 85 BNSS and to revive the complaint when the accused is arrested or produced before the Court.
