Mr. Subrat Tripathi, Ld. Counsel for the SBI Bank Pooth Khurd alongwith Mr. Sudhir Yadav, Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Puth Khurd, Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for the SBI Bank submits that as on date there is a balance of Rs. 11,000/- in the bank account of JD which is not sufficient to satisfy the present decree. On enquiry about the FDRs, it is stated that they have already encashed and adjusted towards the pending loans against such FDRs.

Separate statement of Mr. Sudhir Yadav, Branch Manager, State Bank of India, Puth Khurd, Delhi is recorded accordingly.

Ld. Counsel for the Bank has filed, the statement of account regarding FDRs (account no. 38845561102, 38961773170 and 38377316403) as well as saving account 10112638862 as per the previous order. The same is taken on record.

Ld. Counsel for the DH vehemently submits that the bank has deliberately encashed the FDRs towards repayment of loan. He further submits that the same was done in disobedience of the order dated 22.11.2019 of this Court. The act of bank has caused prejudice

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
