**COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH. 01 & 06 IN S.C.C. NO. 774/2022**

**01.** The present application has been filed for permission to withdraw from the prosecution under Section 321 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. A copy of the State Government's order granting permission to withdraw from the prosecution has been filed by the complainant and is marked as Exh. 07.

**02.** I have perused the letter issued by the Ministry of Industry, Energy, Labour, and Mining, Mantralaya, Mumbai. Upon perusal, it appears that permission has been granted to withdraw this case.

**03.** I have also perused the application filed by the complainant. The complainant has contended that the factory management has paid suitable ex-gratia amount to the injured workers and also the cost of Rs. 1,79,447/- towards treatment of both the injured workers. The management has also complied with the remedial measures suggested to prevent recurrence of such incidents in the future. Upon perusal of the application and

the letter regarding the withdrawal, it appears that the management has complied with the provisions of the Act; therefore, permission may be granted for withdrawal.

**04.** In view of the above, permission is granted to withdraw from the prosecution. It appears that the case is still pending for the plea of the accused. Therefore, considering the provisions of section 321 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the accused can be discharged of the offence. Accordingly, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1. The accused is discharged vide section 321(a) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. The proceeding stands disposed off accordingly.
