01. That, on 12/06/2025, you above named accused being Manager of M/s. Pearson Drums Private Limited, Plot No. L-103, MIDC, Taloja, Taluka Panvel, Dist. Raigad failed to produce the

notice of period of works for adult workers in Form 16 on demand for the purpose of verification / inspection and thereby contravened section 61(1) of the Factories Act, 1948 punishable U/sec. 92 of the said Act and within my cognizance.

02. Secondly, on the above mentioned date and place, you above named accused being Manager of M/s. Pearson Drums Private Limited, failed to maintain leave with wages register in Form 20 and thereby contravened the Rule 105(1) of the Maharashtra Factories Rules, 1963 punishable U/sec.92 of the Factories Act, 1948 and within my cognizance.

:: J U D G M E N T ::

1. Accused Shri. S. K. Singh, Manager of M/s. Pearson Drums Private Limited, Plot No. L-103, MIDC, Taloja, Taluka Panvel, Dist. Raigad has filed the application (Exh. 07) thereby pleading his guilt for the offence committed under section 61(1) of the Factories Act, 1948 and Rule 105(1) of the Maharashtra Factories Rules, 1963 punishable under section 92 of the Factories Act.

2. It is alleged that the accused failed to produce the notice of period of works for adult workers in Form 16 on demand for the purpose of verification / inspection and also failed to maintain leave with wages register in Form 20.

3. By filing application (Exh. 07), the accused has pleaded his guilt. The accused voluntarily pleaded guilty for the offence punishable U/sec. 92 of the said Act. The learned advocate for accused submitted that it is his first offence and is technical in nature. He further submitted that all the shortcomings are now rectified.

4. This is not the offence in which any person is injured or death caused to anybody, therefore, by accepting the plea of guilt of the accused lenient view is taken and minimum punishment of fine can be imposed vide section 92 of the said Act. Hence, I pass the following order.

:: O R D E R ::

1. Accused Shri. S. K. Singh, Manager of M/s. Pearson

Drums Private Limited, is hereby convicted for the offence committed under section 61(1) of the Factories Act, 1948 and Rule 105(1) of the Maharashtra Factories Rules, 1963 punishable under section 92 of the Factories Act, vide section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

2. He shall pay fine of Rs. **2,500/-** (Rs. Two Thousand Five Hundred only), for the offence committed under section 61(1) of the Factories Act, 1948 punishable under section 92 of the Factories Act, in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for 5 days.
3. He shall pay fine of Rs. **2,500/-** (Rs. Two Thousand Five Hundred only), for the offence committed under Rule 105(1) of the Maharashtra Factories Rules, 1963 punishable under section 92 of the Factories Act, in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for 5 days.
4. After realization of fine amount, it shall be credited to the State Exchequer.
5. Bail bonds of the accused stand surrendered.
