ORDER BELOW EXH. 27

- 1] Defendant no. 1 to 5 prayed for condonation of delay 20 days in filing his Say/W.S. to the application.
- 2] Plaintiff resisted the filing their say at **exh. 32**. They contended that, as per Bailff Report at **Exh. 22 and 23** dated 26-04-2014, the defendants were served with suit summons and notice on 22-06-2014. They were required to file their say / W.S. within 30 days and not later then 90 days from the date of service. Despite that, they have failed and neglected to file the same within said period. There is a delay of 22 days. Lastly, prayed for rejection of application.
- 3] Heard learned advocates for the respective parties at length.
- 4] The reason mentioned in the application appears to be reasonable, sound and justifiable one. Moreover, for having effective adjudication of the matter on merits, it is necessary to have the written statement of the defendants on record. In view of this, the following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1] The application **Exh. 27** is hereby allowed.
- 2] No order as to costs.
- 3] The written statement filed by defendant no. 1 to 5 on datd 13-08-2014 is taken on record and marked as **exhibit 46**.
