**Petition for Divorce U/s. 13B of the
Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.**

:: JUDGMENT ::

(Delivered on 10th March, 2026)

- 1) The petitioners have filed this petition for divorce by mutual consent under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

- 2) The petitioners state that, their marriage was solemnized on 13/04/2023 as per Hindu Rites and Rituals at Prakash Vivah Karayalay, Namdeep, Plot No. 21/A/19, Pannel, Raigad. Out of the said wedlock no issue.

- 3) The petitioners further state that, relationship between the petitioners has become strained and their nature, temperament and disposition have become incompatible. They are not in a position to live together as husband and wife any longer. Since 26th December 2023 they have separated from each other. In spite of attempts made for their reconciliation they are unable to live together. In the circumstances the petitioners have decided to break-

up the relationship as husband and wife by way of decree of divorce by mutual consent and hence filed present petition.

4) Both petitioners have filed on record their evidence on affidavits vide **Exh. 11 & 12**, Copy of marriage certificate & marriage photograph, Copy of Aadhar card of petitioner nos. 1 & 2.

5) Both the petitioners have decided to break-up the relationship as husband and wife by their free consent. This Court has verified that there is no force or coercion on both the parties. All the disputes between the parties have been resolved. In the circumstances the petitioners have decided to break-up the relationship as husband and wife by way of decree of divorce by mutual consent.

6) It appears that, present petition comes within the jurisdiction of this court. After the marriage they have filed present petition on 30/09/2025. The petitioners were residing separately for the period of more than 02 years prior to filing of present petition. It appears that, there is no chance of reunion of the parties.

7) The cooling period of six months is waived. The petitioners are firm for taking mutual divorce. Hence, in view of above referred evidence the petitioners are entitled

for decree by way of mutual consent. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following order.

:: ORDER ::

- 1) Petition is allowed.
- 2) The marriage solemnized between the petition no.1 and petitioner no.2 on 13/04/2023 is hereby dissolved under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
- 3) Decree be drawn up accordingly.
