1. The application is filed by plaintiff for taking the legal heirs of defendant no. 4 on record.
2. Perused. Defendant failed to file their say.
3. The defendant no. 4 is reported to have died on 24.01.2019. The suit is for declaration and injunction.
4. The deceased defendant no. 4 is survived by two sons and three daughters. They are legal heirs of the deceased defendant the right to sue, therefore, survives.
5. In order to enable the court to effectively and completely adjudicate upon and settle all the questions involved in the suit, it is necessary to allow the application to bring on record the legal representatives of deceased defendant No. 4.
6. There are no other heirs except those named in the application.
7. It is therefore necessary in the interest of justice to allow the application.

1. The application is allowed.
