

ORDER BELOW EXH.80

The present application is filed by plaintiff under Order V Rule 20 of Code of Civil Procedure.

2. The plaintiff avers that defendant no.14 is avoiding service of summons. Hence, he prayed to allow the application.

3. Perused application, affidavit and proceedings. The summons were issued to defendant no.14 on 13/09/2019 through R.P.A.D. But it returned as unclaimed. Therefore, summon on defendant no.14 remained unserved. Therefore, it seems that defendant no.14 is purposely avoiding service of summons.

4. Satisfactory reasons are brought on record to believe that, the said defendant no.14 could not be served in the ordinary way. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Summons be served on defendant no. 14 by affixing a copy of summons on the door of the company of defendant no.14 where the defendant is known to have its registered office as per document no.1061/2012 and also affixing a copy in some conspicuous place in the Court-house.
