

ORDER BELOW EXH.14

The present application is filed by plaintiff under Order V Rule 20 of Code of Civil Procedure.

2. The plaintiff avers that defendant no.1 to 3 are avoiding service of summons. He contended that defendant no.1 to 3 came to know about the present suit therefore they are purposely avoiding the service of summons. The house mentioned in their residential address are owned by them. Hence, he prayed to allow the application.

3. Perused application, affidavit and proceedings. As per bailiff report defendant no.1 to 3 refused to accept the summons. Therefore, the summons remained unserved. The application is supported by an affidavit. Therefore, it seems that plaintiff no.1 to 3 are purposely avoiding service of summons. Hence, summons remained unserved.

4. Satisfactory reasons are brought on record to believe that, the said defendant no.1 to 3 could not be served in the ordinary way. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Summons be served on defendant no.1 to 3 by affixing a copy of summons on some conspicuous part of the house in which the defendant is known to have last resided and also
