

ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

Heard learned advocate for the complainant. Perused the complaint, documents filed along with it, verification of the complainant on oath. The complainant alleged that the accused issued a cheque to the complainant for commercial transaction. The payment of the cheque was stopped. He inquired with the bank and came to know that the cheque is of the bank account of the sister of the accused. All the requisite documents are on record. The ingredients of offences punishable under Section 417 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code is prima-facie made out in the complaint. There are sufficient grounds for proceeding against the accused. Hence, issue process for offences punishable under Section 417 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code against accused.
