

ORDER BELOW EXH. 01.

The complainant filed present complaint against accused no.1 to 6 for offence punishable under section 388, 324, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860, process is also issued for said offence on 01.04.2019. As the section 388 & 324 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 carry punishment exceeding 2 years, case should have been registered as regular case, however, it is left to be converted into regular case. In view of offence levelled against the accused, after their appearance before the Court, the complainant was bound to lead his evidence as per section 244 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, however, instead of leading evidence, the complainant filed pursis at Exh.47 for withdrawal of this case. As the complainant does not want to proceed with the case, matter cannot be proceeded against accused as per section 246 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973, rather, it would be appropriate to discharge them for want of evidence as per section 245 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973. Hence following order is passed.

ORDER

1. Case is disposed off as withdrawn by the complainant.
2. The accused no.1 to 6 are discharged of the offence punishable under section 388, 324, 504, 506 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 vide section 245 of the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973.
3. Bail bonds of accused are cancelled and their surety stand discharged.
