ORDER ON BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION ACT

The petitioner has filed this petition U/S.13(3) of Birth and Death Registration Act seeking to direct the respondent for registering her date of birth in the concerned register.

02. It is alleged in the petition that, the date of birth of petitioner has not been entered in the Birth and Death Register of the Respondent, due to lack of knowledge.

03. Inspite of service of notice, the respondent remained absent before the court and hence placed exparte.

04. Petitioner examined herself as PW.1 and got marked documents from Ex.P.01 to 03. Respondent not let in evidence.

05. Heard arguments, perused the materials on record.

06. Petitioner examined herself as P.W.1 and has produced the documents at Ex.P.01 to Ex.P.03. Ex.P.1 is the endorsement issued by The Commissioner, BBMP, Bangalore. *Ex.P.2 & 3 are the notarized copies of Adhar card and PAN card of the petitioner.* All these documents reveals that date of birth of the petitioner is, **21.06.1982**. Ex.P.1 is the endorsement issued by the respondent which reveals that, the date of birth of petitioner has not entered in the concerned register.

07. In spite of service of notice, respondent remained absent. Hence, the pleadings and evidence placed by the petitioner remained unchallenged. The documents are in consonance with the pleadings and evidence of the petitioner. There is nothing on record to disbelieve the case of petitioner. The registration date of birth of the petitioner is required for further correspondence. Hence, she requires

the birth certificate. Hence, the petition is entitled to be allowed. Accordingly, the following;

ORDER

Petition is allowed.

Respondent is directed to cause entry in the concerned register, the date of birth of the petitioner by name **SUMATHI, D/o NARAYANA and SMT.ANKARIA GURAMMA**, who was born on **21.06.1982**, at No.81, Corporation Houseses, Flat Form Road, Jakkaraynkere North, Seshadripuram, Bengaluru – 560 020.

Issue direction to the respondent to issue **Birth Certificate** accordingly, after collecting necessary late fee from the petitioner.
