It appears that the complainant prayed for forward the complaint to the police under Section 156(3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. It appears that the learned in-charge Court kept the matter for verification.

03. All the offences mentioned in the complaint are non cognizable. The complainant leveled Section 505(B) of I.P.C. But, there is no such offence. There is offence under Section 505 part I, II & III. There is no prima facie material for the offence punishable under Section 505 part II of I.P.C. Offences under Section 505 part I & II of I.P.C. are non cognizable but the offence under Section 505 part II of I.P.C. is cognizable. Hence, prayer of the complainant to forward the complaint under Section 156(3) of Cr. P. C. is rejected. The matter is kept for verification of the complainant.
