JUDGMENT

The accused is present before the Court. He submitted his plea of guilt. The prescribed punishment for the offence has been explained to him. Even the consequences thereof also explained to him. He tendered his plea of guilt.

The substance of accusation of the accused recorded and the same also again read over and explained to him. The accused pleaded guilt. I accept that the accused is pleading guilt voluntarily. The accused pleaded leniency. He has submitted that he is the only bread earner of his family. He is not previously convicted. Considering his age and no antecedents, leniency should be shown to the accused. As a result, sentence of fine and imprisonment till rising of the Court will suffice the purpose. Consequently, I pass following order:-

ORDER

1.	The accused Amresh Kumar Gangaram is hereby convicted u/s. 275 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for the offence punishable u/s. 285 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and he is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.5000/- (Rs. Five thousand only) and in default of payment of fine to suffer S.I. for 03 days.
2.	Copy of this judgment be provided to accused free of costs.
