

Order below Exh. 9 through Uran police station

By way of this application, Officer-in-charge of Uran police station has prayed for permission to auction the muddemal in present case and to credit the sale proceeds to Government. He has contended that in said case, 20 ltr. drum of base oil, plastic drum and one pipe have been seized. He has filed final report which is pending in this court. There is no sufficient and proper space in police station to keep said muddemal. Storage of said muddemal in police station would lead into spreading of stench or bad odor in the premises of police station. It is also hazardous for the security purpose. Hence, he has prayed to auction said muddemal.

2. Heard learned A.P.P. She argued in the line of the application on behalf of the police authority. Perused record of case. The accused is absent in present case. The Officer-in-charge of police station has himself sought for auction of the above property for the above mentioned reason. Hence, I do not find any impediment to auction the property. But before doing so, it would be proper to direct the Officer-in-charge of police station to prepare the panchnama along with the photographs and as per rules. Hence, in sequel I pass following order.

ORDER

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	The muddemal property i.e. 20 ltr. drum of base oil, plastic

drum and one pipe is allowed to be auctioned by Sr. Police inspector, Uran police station as per rules and the sale credits be credited to the Government.
