

Order below Exhibit 1

This is suit for partition and temporary injunction. Ld. Advocate for Plaintiffs submitted that Suit properties are ancestral properties of plaintiffs and defendants. However, Defendants are trying to sell the properties. Therefore, Defendants may be restrained from creating third party interest in the suit properties.

I have perused the documents on record. It appears that suit property no. 1 to 3 are in the name of Defendants. However Plaintiffs are claiming their share in that properties. In such circumstances without giving Defendants, an opportunity of being heard, it will not be desirable to grant any ad-interim ex-parte relief in the present matter. Hence, It will be just and proper to issue summons and notices to the Defendants. Hence, Issue summons and notices to the Defendants to appear and file their written Statement and say if any, within 30 days from the service of summons and notices. R/w on 23/06/2026.
