1. These applications at Exhibit 58 and 60 are to set aside abatement against plaintiff no. 11 as she has expired on 28.07.2025 and to condone the delay to bring her legal heirs on record.
2. It is submitted that plaintiff no. 11 has expired on 28.07.2025. They did not receive the death information in time. Since the application to bring legal heirs on record was not filed within the time limit, the suit is abated against plaintiff no. 11. The legal heirs of deceased plaintiff no. 11 are required to be brought on record and therefore delay to bring legal heirs of deceased plaintiff no. 11 are required to be condoned. Therefore, the said applications need to be allowed.
3. Defendant no. 1 to 11 filed their say and objected.
4. Perused the applications. Heard the Ld. Advocate for the plaintiffs and defendants.

5. It is submitted that the plaintiff no. 11 has expired on 28.07.2025. Since, the death information was not received on time, legal heirs of plaintiff no. 11 could not be brought on record within the time limit. There is a delay of almost 4 month and 25 days in bringing legal heirs of plaintiff no. 11 on record.
6. Considering the above facts, the applications deserves to be allowed. However, the delay needs to be compensated. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

:: Order ::

1. Applications at Exhibit 58 and 60 are allowed.
2. The abatement against plaintiff no. 11 is set aside and the delay to bring legal heirs of plaintiff no. 11 is condoned subject to cost of Rs. 500/- to be paid to the TLSA.
