1. This is an application filed by the plaintiffs praying to condone the delay in bringing the LRs on record.
2. It is contended by the plaintiffs that, defendant no.1 Baliram Dattatrey Patil died on 01.04.2024. After his death, his legal representatives had to be brought on record, but due to lack of knowledge by the plaintiffs, LRs of deceased defendant no.1 could not be brought on record, which caused delay of 403 days in bringing his LRs on record.
3. While the defendants has strongly objected the application submitting that, plaintiffs were aware about the death of defendant no.1 yet caused delay in bringing his Lrs on record. Hence, prayed to impose heavy cost.
4. Perused the application, supporting affidavit, say, documents filed on record.
5. After perusing the documents, it seems that plaintiffs delayed bring LRs of deceased defendant no.1 on record. The plaintiffs did not mention specific reason for such delay. Yet not bringing LRs of deceased defendant no.1 may affect the trial and execution of the suit. Hence, the
