1. This is an application filed by the plaintiffs praying to bring the LR of defendant no.1 on record.
2. It is contended by the plaintiffs that, defendant no.1 Baliram Dattatrey Patil died on 01.04.2024. After his death, his legal representatives had to be brought on record, but due to lack of knowledge by the plaintiffs, LR of deceased defendant no.1 could not be brought on record within 90 days. Hence caused more than 90 days delay in bringing his LR on record.
3. While defendants strongly objected and prayed to reject this application.
4. Perused the application, supporting affidavit, say, documents filed on record.
5. After perusing the documents, it seems that plaintiffs delayed bring LR of deceased defendant no.1 on record. The plaintiffs did not mention specific reason for such delay. Yet not bringing LR of deceased defendant no.1 may affect the trial and execution of the suit. Hence, the order:

Order

- i. The application is allowed subject to depositing cost vide Exh.29.

- ii. The plaintiffs are directed to carry out amendment by taking LRs of the deceased defendant no.1 on record after depositing the cost.
