

Order below Exh. 3 through Uran police station

By way of this application, Officer-in-charge of Uran police station has prayed for permission to dispose off muddemal in present case. He has contended that in said case 7 bottles of Mcdowells No. 1 make liquor each 180 ml., 17 bottles of Mcdowells No. 1 make liquor each 90 ml., and 22 bottles country liquor G.M.Santra each 90 ml. have been seized. He has filed final report which is pending in this court. There is no sufficient and proper space in police station to keep said muddemal. Storage of said muddemal in police station would lead into spreading of stench or bad odour in the premises of police station. It is also hazardous for the security purpose. Hence, he has prayed to dispose off said muddemal.

2. Heard learned A.P.P. She argued in the line of the application on behalf of the police authority. Perused record of case. The accused is absent in present case. The Officer-in-charge of police station has himself sought for disposal of the above property for the above mentioned reason. Hence, I do not find any impediment to dispose of the property. But before doing so, it would be proper to direct the Officer-in-charge of police station to prepare the panchnama along with the photographs and as per rules. Hence, in sequel I pass following order.

ORDER

1.	Application is allowed.
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2.	The said muddemal i.e. 7 bottles of Mcdowells No. 1 make liquor each 180 ml., 17 bottles of Mcdowells No. 1 make liquor each 90 ml., and 22 bottles country liquor G.M.Santra each 90 ml. total worth Rs. 3,180/- be handed over to Superintendent, State Excise Department, Raigad-Alibag for disposal according to law.
