

Order below Exh. 15 through Uran police station

By way of this application, Officer-in-charge of Uran police station has prayed for permission to auction the muddemal in present case and to credit the sale proceeds to Government. He has contended that in said case, tempo bearing no. MH-04/FP-0276, approximately 200 ltr. of flammable chemical in 2 iron and 2 plastic drums, 25 plastic drums, plastic pipe and diesel motor pump have been seized. He has filed final report which is pending in this court. Out of which custody of tempo is returned to applicant Aasha Yadav. There is no sufficient and proper space in police station to keep said muddemal. It is also hazardous for the security purpose. Hence, he has prayed to auction said muddemal.

2. Heard learned A.P.P. She argued in the line of the application on behalf of the police authority. Perused record of case. The accused is absent in present case. The Officer-in-charge of police station has himself sought for auction of the above property for the above mentioned reason. Hence, I do not find any impediment to auction the property. But before doing so, it would be proper to direct the Officer-in-charge of police station to prepare the panchnama along with the photographs and as per rules. Hence, in sequel I pass following order.
