PWDVA Application no.14/2025

(Sayali Manish Nagori V/s Manish Ramvilas Nagori)

Order below Exh. No.12

1. This is an application seeking interim monetary relief of Rs.15,000/- per month from the respondent.
2. It is contended by the applicant no.1 that, respondent is her husband. Their marriage was solemnized on 11.06.2015, out of this wedlock they have a daughter namely Laisha i.e. applicant no.2. Since beginning of the marriage, the respondent has subjected the applicant to domestic violence, abuses, humiliating words and insults on multiple occasions. The respondent has willfully neglected and refused to maintain the applicant and their minor daughter. He has failed to provide any financial support despite having sufficient means and capacity to do so. All necessary expenses of applicant no.2 including school fees, books, clothing, transportation and medical cost have been borne by the father of applicant no.1. The respondent has consistently evaded his responsibility and avoided paying any money for the maintenance of applicants. The applicant has no independent substantial income and is unable to meet these expenses, while respondent is able bodied man having sufficient means to earn and support his family.

Hence prayed to grant interim monetary relief of Rs. 15,000/- per month to the applicants for their livelihood and the medical expenses.

3. Summons has been duly served upon the respondent on 23.09.2025 as per report vide Exh.8 yet the respondent did not appear in this application before the Court. Hence Ex-parte order was passed against him on 29.10.2025. Hence this application is being decided uncontested and unchallenged.

4. Perused the application, affidavit, documents filed on record. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant.

5. Considering the averments in the application, the unchallenged evidence on record, and the fact that summons were duly served upon the respondent on 23.09.2025 (vide Exh.8) and despite such service the respondent remained absent before this Court, leading to an ex-parte order on 29.10.2025, it is evident that the respondent has willfully neglected and refused to maintain the aggrieved applicant and their minor daughter Laisha. Disputes between the parties not only broke trust among them but also made the situation perverted. Here it is not subject matter of discussion that who borne expenses of marriage, but the present and future relief as par PWDV Act. Applicants and respondent are residing separate shows dispute between them, but being wife she can not be deprived from her certain rights, irrespective of disputes except the grounds given under various laws, it is duty of husband to provide shelter and to maintain his wife, and he can not escape from his

duty.

6. No doubt final adjudication in this case may take some more time by giving detail and fair opportunity to both the sides, till then I find that applicants are entitled for interim monetary relief from respondent. Applicants contended that, they have no source of income and they are unable to work to earn, while respondent has income sources. Applicants failed to show any evidence or sufficient reason to believe property or income source of respondent. The respondent, an able-bodied man with sufficient means, has failed to provide any financial support for the basic needs, education, medical care and other essential expenses of the applicants, who have no independent means of livelihood. In the circumstances, the applicants are unable to sustain themselves without financial assistance. Even considering age and health of respondent, it is expected that he may earn around Rs.300/- per day i.e. Rs.9,000/- per month by labour work. Considering life standards, needs, requirements of applicants and respondent, I find that Rs.3,000/- per month to the applicant No.1 and Rs. 2,000/- per month to applicant No. 2 will be justifiable amount as interim monetary relief. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

**ORDER**

- i) Application vide Exh. 12 is partly allowed.
- ii) Respondent is hereby directed to pay interim monetary relief of Rs.3,000/- (Rs. Three Thousand only) per month to applicant no.1 and Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. Two thousand only)

per month to applicant no.2 from the date of filing of this application till final disposal of the main application.
