JUDGMENT

The accused appeared before the Court and filed pursis at Exh.4 admitting that he had committed an offence. Therefore, I have recorded his plea and explained him the consequences of his pleading guilty. In spite of it, the accused pleaded guilty. His plea being voluntarily made, I accept the same and as per provision of Section 252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure proceed to pass the following order to meet the

ends of justice.

ORDER

1.	The accused Accused no.2 Shri Madhav Dhalaram Devashi, is hereby convicted for violating the Rules Contravention of Section 18(1) of The Legal Metrology Act, 2009 read with Rule 18(2) of The Legal Metrology (packaged commodities) Rules, 2011 which is punishable under section 36(1) of the said act and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand only), in default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for one month.
2.	The accused is entitled to set off u/s. 428 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, if any.
3.	Copy of this judgment be provided to the accused free of costs.
