Order below Exhibit 1 in Civil MA No. 325 of 2025

1. The present application is filed by applicants for issuing Heirship Certificate in their names. It is contended that deceased-Dharmubai Vishwanath Gharat @ Dharmubai Yashwant Gharat died intestate on 14.12.1979. Applicant no. 1 and 2 are sons, applicant no. 3 and 4 are daughters of the deceased.
2. Public notices were issued in daily newspaper 'Dainik Vadalwara' (Exhibit 25) for calling objections from public at large. Similarly, proclamation was also issued (Exhibit 8). However, no one has raised any objection.
3. In support of the present application, the applicant no. 2 i.e. Narayan Kashinath Gharat has filed his affidavit at Exhibit 11. Applicants have also placed on record verified copy of Aadhar Card of the applicant no. 1 to 4 (Exhibit 13, 16, 19 and 22), verified copy of Pan Card of the applicant no. 1 to 4 (Exhibit 14, 17, 20 and 23), verified copy of Ration Card of the applicant no. 1 to 4 (Exhibit 15, 18, 21 and 24), copy of death certificate of deceased-Dharmubai Vishwanath Gharat (Exhibit 30), copy of death certificate of deceased-Kashinath Vishwanath Gharat (Exhibit 31) and death certificate of deceased-Tulsabai

Kashinath Gharat (Exhibit 36). There is no objection taken by any person and therefore, the claim of applicant regarding she, being the legal heirs of the deceased-Dharmubai Vishwanath Gharat @ Dharmubai Yashwant Gharat remained unchallenged.

4. There is discrepancy in the description of the properties described in the application and the award viz-a-viz the name of the owner. The heirship certificate is mere recognition of legal heirs of the deceased. No rights in respect of any property is determined. **Hence, I am not inclined to mention any property in the order.**
5. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the applicants are entitled for the Heirship Certificate in their name as the legal heirs of the deceased. No rights in respect of any property has been determined. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:

::ORDER::

1. The application is partly allowed.
2. The Heirship Certificate be issued in the name of the applicant no. 1) Machhindranath Kashinath Gharat, 2) Narayan Kashinath Gharat, 3) Pushpa Pravin Thakur @ Pushpa Kashinath Gharat and 4) Yamini Mohan Patil @ Yamini Kashinath Gharat as the legal heirs of the deceased-Dharmubai Vishwanath Gharat @ Dharmubai Yashwant Gharat on payment of requisite Court fees by them.
3. No rights in respect of any of the property has been determined.
