

**: ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN CRI. MISC. APPLICATION NO.**  
**34/2026 :**  
**(CNR No. MHRG15-000147-2026)**  
(Passed on 16.03.2026)

- 1) This is an application seeking a regular bail, made by accused **Komal Nivrutti Ramanbainwad**, concerning the offence punishable under section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, in Crime No.31/2026 registered with Mhasla Police Station.
- 2) It is contended that the accused did not commit any offence. She has falsely been implicated in the crime. During her Police Custody itself the investigation of the crime has been completed. In search of house disproportionate assets have not been found. The accused is a woman and her further detention is not necessary. She is ready to abide by all the conditions. There are no criminal antecedents against her. It is submitted to allow the application.
- 3) The Investigating Officer and the Ld. A.P.P. for the State, opposed the application by filing say (Exh.4). It is contended that the offence is serious, registered under section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. On being released accused is likely to pressurize the witnesses and the complainant. The investigation is at primary stage. The accused is from other district and on being released, she would not appear before the

Court. It is to be investigated whether there are accomplices to the accused for committing the crime. It is submitted to reject the application.

4) Heard both sides and perused the record. Ld. Advocate Mr. V. U. Ghayal for accused, and the Ld. A.P.P. Mr. Y. A. Tendulkar for the State, iterated the contentions made in the application and say, respectively.

5) Ld. Advocate for accused would submit that further custody of the accused is not necessary with Anti-Corruption Bureau.

6) The Ld. A.P.P. would submit that accused no.1 came to be arrested. The accused is not entitled to be released on bail, at this stage.

7) It is seen that the accused came to be arrested on 06.03.2026 and underwent Police Custody Remand and now is in Judicial Custody. No criminal antecedents have been pointed out against her. The accused is 26 years female employed with Government. Further detention does not appear must to complete the remaining investigation.

8) All other aspects need not be gone into detail at this stage. All in all, the accused is entitled to be released on bail on

certain conditions. Hence, the following order:-

**: ORDER :**

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) Applicant **Komal Nivrutti Ramanbainwad**, concerning the offence punishable under section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, in Crime No.31/2026 registered with Mhasla Police Station, be released on Personal Bond of Rs.30,000/- (Rs. Thirty thousand only), with surety in the like amount, on the following conditions:-
  - (a) She shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any of the witnesses and shall not tamper the prosecution evidence.
  - (b) She shall attend the office of Anti-Corruption Bureau, Raiad-Alibag on 20.03.2026 and 27.03.2026, from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and as and when directed by the Anti-Corruption Bureau, Raiad-Alibag to do so, strictly according to law, till presentation of final report, if any, or passing of the further order, whichever be the earlier.
  - (c) She shall furnish her detail address, contact number, names and addresses of two relatives with their phone numbers.

- (d) She shall not commit any offence.
  
- (e) She shall not leave India without permission of this Court.
