A W A R D

The petitioner, alongwith his Advocate Mr. Sameer Nadkar, who has been authorized by Advocate Mr. J. J. Mandavkar (as per Exh.20) are present before Lok Adalat.

(2) Advocate Mr. S. G. Dhakwal, who has been authorized by Advocate Shaista K. Thakur for respondent no.2 (As per Exh.22), who has been also authorized by Respondent No.2 Insurance Company to sign the Settlement Deed (As per Exh.21), are present before Lok Adalat.

(3) Ld. Advocate for petitioner would submit that the matter has been settled between the Petitioner and Respondent No.2 as per following Terms of Compromise:

Terms of Compromise

(i) The Respondent no.2 **TATA AIG General Insurance Com. Ltd.** do deposit **Rs.4,00,000 (Rs. Four lakh only)** as full and final settlement, inclusive the amount of No Fault Liability, **within six weeks** from the date of Award, in default, the petitioner is entitled to claim **interest @ 9% p.a.** thereon, from the date of Compromise.

(ii) The petitioner is waiving his right to recover the claim against Respondent No.1.

(iii) **Seen Exh. Nos.20, 21, and 22.**

(iv) As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (Civil) No.534/2020 dated 16.11.2021 and 16.03.2021, the Respondent No.2. is directed to deposit compensation amount of **Rs.4,00,000 (Rs. Four lakh only)**, alongwith interest, if any, in the account of Ex-Officio Member of M.A.C.T. Mangaon-Raigad,

maintained with State Bank of India, Branch-Mangaon bearing Account No.40784303152 (IFSC No. SBIN0000276, Bank Branch No.0000276).

(v) The compensation amount, with interest, if any, be paid to the petitioner by depositing it in his Saving Bank Accounts, maintained with any of the Nationalized Banks of his choice.


(vi) A copy of the Award be sent on the e-mail address of respondent no.2.


