

: ORDER BELOW EXH.18 IN SESSIONS CASE NO.33/2022 :
(CNR No. MHRG15-000269-2022)
(Passed on 03.12.2024)

- 1) The present application is filed by applicant/accused under section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for regular bail.
- 2) The applicant contended that on 15.02.2022 the report was registered at Kolad police station that some unknown person had committed murder of victim by assaulting her on her thighs, stomach, chest and neck. He is arrested in said offence. The Investigating Officer has completed the investigation and has filed charge-sheet against him.
- 3) He further contended that the Investigating Officer has not deposited the muddemal in the Court. Therefore, trial is prolonging. He is behind bars for more than two years. He prayed that he may be released on regular bail.
- 4) Ld. A.P.P. filed his say at Exh.19. He contended that the offence committed by the applicant is serious in nature. There is sufficient evidence against the applicant. The prosecution has examined two witnesses. The trial is in progress. The Investigating Officer has also deposited the muddemal in the Hon'ble Court. He further contended that if the applicant is released on regular bail, there are chances that he may pressurize the witnesses and tamper the evidence of prosecution.

He prayed that the application be rejected.

5) Heard Ld. advocates appearing for parties.

6) On perusal of material available on record, it appears that the earlier bail application of applicant was decided on 20.12.2022. Thereafter the prosecution has examined two witnesses. The Roznama shows that the Kolad police station has given report about muddemal at Exh.19. The trial is in progress. The offence committed by the applicant is serious in nature. Therefore, if the applicant is released on regular bail, there are chances that he may pressurize the witnesses and tamper the evidence of prosecution. Taking into consideration all the above facts, in my opinion, the applicant is not entitled to be released on regular bail. Hence, I proceed to pass following order :-

: ORDER :

1) The application is rejected.
