

**: ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN MACP M.A. NO.10/2024 :**  
**(CNR No. MHRG15-000541-2024)**  
**(Passed on 02.04.2026)**

- 1) This is an application seeking release of the compensation amount, granted to Santosh Raju Chavan (since dead), in favour of the applicants Kusum Raju Chavan and Sandeep Raju Chavan.
- 2) It is submitted that by allowing M.A.C.P No. 13 of 2018 on 23.12.2022, amount of compensation of Rs.2,24,000/- alongwith interest, had been awarded in favour of Santosh Raju Chavan.
- 3) On death of Santosh Raju Chavan on 05.02.2023, the applicants being mother and brother of Santosh Raju Chavan, respectively, are entitled to the amount of compensation. There is no other legal representative to the deceased Santosh Chavan. It is submitted to allow the application.
- 4) Ld. Advocate for respondent (Insurance Company) filed say (Exh.11) stating therein that the amount could be paid on proper verification of the legal representatives.
- 5) The office reported that amount has been deposited and had been kept in Fixed Deposit in the name of Santosh Raju

Chavan through the account of this Tribunal.

6) The application is supported by an affidavit. Death Certificate of Santosh and a copy of Ration Card have been produced on record.

7) Ld. Advocate for the applicants would submit that in view of the above circumstances, and the ratio laid down by **the Hon'ble Andhra Pradesh High Court in Chitrapu China Bapanaiah and others Vs. Union of India, (2006 ACJ 2602)**, Succession Certificate/Heirship Certificate would not require. There are no other legal representative.

8) Considering above mentioned aspects, and the ratio laid down in the cited case (supra), the applicants are entitled to get amount alongwith interest thereof. Hence, the following order:

**: ORDER :**

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) An amount of Rs.2,90,256/- (F.D.R. No.11, dated 28.11.2024), Fixed Deposited to M.A.C.T. Ex-officio Member Account No.40784303152, alongwith interest, be paid to the applicant nos.1 and 2, by a premature release of the Fixed Deposit.

- 3) The abovesaid amount be apportioned among the petitioners, as under:-
  - (1) Applicant no.1: – Mother – **80%**; and
  - (2) Applicant no.2: - Brother – **20%**.
- 4) The payment be made in the Bank Accounts of respective applicants, maintained with any of the Nationalized Banks, of their choice, by R.T.G.S. mode/Account Payee cheque, on proper identification.
- 5) The office do the necessary compliance for disbursal of the above mentioned amount by making necessary correspondence with the Bank.
- 6) Application is disposed of, accordingly.
