

ORDER BELOW EXH.09 IN CRI. REV.APPL.NO.14 OF 2024

(Passed on 17.03.2026.)

- 1) The present application has been filed by respondent No.01 **Manju Mahendra Jain**, for obtaining “no objection” of this Court for permission to travel abroad.
- 2) It is contended that, applicant has passport bearing No.AE537550. The case has been filed against the applicant by respondent at Ld. J.M.F.C. Roha, wherein order in favour of respondent has been passed and against said order present revision has been filed. In view of notification of Ministry of External Affairs it is necessary to obtain “no objection” from concerned Court where case against a person has been pending. Respondent intends to visit foreign country. Hence, filed present application, supported by affidavit.
- 3) Ld. Advocate Shri. Sanap for applicant filed say overleaf of application and strongly opposed application.
- 4) Heard both the side, perused application and say.
- 5) It appears that no process has been issued against the respondent in the case lodged against them before Ld. J.M.F.C. Roha. The offences alleges therein are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. Respondent is local resident and would not flee from justice. Thus, there is no chances of absconding and to delay trial in case process is issued against respondent. It was held in case of **Maneka Gandhi Vs. Union of India, (1978) 1 SCC 248**, that mere pendency of criminal

proceeding can not be a ground to deny permission to obtain passport or travel abroad unless compelling reasons exists.

6) The presence of respondent can be secured by imposing conditions. Considering facts and circumstances, it is necessary to allow the application of respondent seeking no objection for traveling abroad. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

:: ORDER ::

01. The application(Exh.09) is allowed.
02. This Court has no objection for traveling of respondent No.01 **Manju Mahendra Jain** to abroad.
03. The respondent shall report to the Court prior to leaving country and after arrival from foreign country.
