

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.09

- 1) The present application has been filed by Ld. Advocate Shri. Pandhare on behalf of accused for releasing accused on personal bond with a view to arrange surety. It is submitted that, on 04.03.2026 bail application of accused was allowed, but there is no one to arrange surety for him. Hence, accused could not comply with the bail order.
- 2) Ld. A.P.P. Shri. Tendulkar strongly opposed said application.
- 3) It appears that, this Court has allowed bail application of accused on 04.03.2026 and thereby order release accused on furnishing surety of Rs.25,000/-. Accused could not comply with the bail order. In the present application accused seeking permission to release him on personal bond in order to arrange surety. It appears that, accused has been deprived of benefit of bail order only due to non arrangement of surety. The detention of accused in such circumstances would defeat the very purpose of granting bail. Hence, this Court finds it appropriate to relax the condition regarding furnishing surety temporarily in the interest of justice. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

1. The application(Exh.09) is allowed.

2. Accused **Rupesh Shankar Utekar** be released on bail executing personal bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only).
3. The accused shall furnish surety in like amount within a period of fifteen days from this order.
4. In case accused fails to furnish surety within stipulated period the bail granted shall stands canceled and he shall surrender before the Court.
5. Accused shall abide by all other terms and conditions imposed in the earlier bail order dt.04.03.2026.
