The plaintiff has filed present application and requested for permission to produce on record document in support of his suit.

02. Defendants have filed their say below application and requested to deliver appropriate order.

03. It appears the plaintiff is intended to produce on record register agreement to sale dated 10.09.2008. It appears plaintiff already filed affidavite in lieu of examination-in-chief. It appears the plaintiff has instituted present suit for specific performance. Considering nature of suit it appears it was incumbent upon the plaintiff to produce on record all the documents in support of his evidence. In this regard order 13 rule 1 of CPC is vivid and clear that, all the parties to the suit must produce on record documents in support of their case before framing charge.
