Present : Shri Amit Chutani, Advocate counsel for complainant.

Complainant is present and examined as CW1. Heard on the point of summoning of accused. As per the allegations of complainant against accused cheque No. 098902 dated 10.08.2021, account no. 13931000027324 worth Rs.20,000/- was issued in favour of complainant by the accused which was dishonoured vide memo dated 10.08.2021 with the remarks of 'Funds Insufficient'. Complainant had issued the legal notice but accused did not pay the amount. Hence, the present complaint.

2. On filing of complaint, complainant examined himself as CW1 and produced documents i.e. Original Cheque is Ex. C-1, memo dated 10.08.2021 is Ex. C-2, Legal notice is Ex. C-3, postal receipt is Ex. C-4 and Registered Envelop as Ex.C-5. In view of the present circumstances, it is clear that the complainant has approached the Court within time after the dishonour of cheque and after issuing notice, therefore, prima facie case is made out under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, accused is liable to be summoned to face trial. Let, accused be summoned on filing of copies of complaint,PF,RC etc within seven days for 04.02.2022.
