Statutory requirement u/s 82 of Cr.P.C stands duly complied with. Accused has failed to come present in the court. Hence, the **accused Vivek Goel son of Late Sh. Ravinder Kumar Goel resident of House No. 161, Hardayal Nagar, Jalandhar** is hereby declared as proclaimed person. Necessary intimation in this regard be sent to the concerned police authority for making the relevant entry in the police record.

Learned counsel for complainant has made a statement to the effect that affidavit Ex.CA along with documents Ex.C.1 to Ex.C.6 already tendered in the evidence of complainant may be read as the statement of complainant under section 299 Cr.P.C. and closed the evidence on behalf of complainant under section 299 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel for complainant has further suffered a statement to the effect that at this stage he does not have any list of property either movable or immovable in the name of the accused for the purpose of attachment under section 83 Cr.P.C. Therefore, proceedings under section 83 Cr.P.C. can not be initiated for the purpose of attachment. File be consigned to the record room to be retrieved as and when the accused surrenders or is arrested/produced by the police.
