**ORDER BELOW EXH. 4**

- 1] This is an application filed by the applicant **Shakib Mustafa Palte** under section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (in short “BNSS”) for interim protection in the event of arrest.
- 2] Heard Ld. advocate Shri. Sahil Morey for applicant. Perused FIR and documents placed on record.
- 3] On perusal of FIR it appears that in Damat and Mamdapur village construction project by name Sukoon Empire is going on. Builder of the said project used word ‘Halal’ while advertising for sale of flats. Therefore, it seems that Sukoon Residency is available only for Muslim persons. The cognizance was taken by National Human

Rights Commission. Many news channel had taken interviews of people about the Sukoon Residency regarding 'Halal'. While giving interview to news channel the applicant Shakib Mustafa Palte expressed his opinion against Hindu Community, which affected the feeling of the Hindu people. Therefore, informant lodged report to Neral Police Station vide C.R.No. 32/2026 for the offences punishable under Section 196(1)(a), 196(1)(b), 299 and 353(3) of the BNS.

- 4] Offence under section 353(3) is punishable with imprisonment five years. Nothing is required to be recovered at the instance of the present applicant. The applicant is permanent resident of Mamdapur, Neral, Tal. Karjat, District- Raigad. Considering nature of allegation custodial interrogation is not necessary. Under these peculiar circumstances, interim protection can be granted by imposing certain stringent conditions. As a result, I pass following order.

**:: ORDER ::**

1. Application at Exh. 4 is allowed.
2. Till next date, in the event of arrest in connection with crime registered in Neral Police Station vide C.R.No. 32/2026 for the offences punishable under Section 196(1)(a), 196(1)(b), 299 and 353(3) of the BNS, applicant **Shakib Mustafa Palte** be released on furnishing

PB and S.B of Rs.60,000/-(Rupees Sixty Thousand) with one or two solvent surety in like amount.

3. Applicant shall not tamper the evidence of Prosecution.
4. Applicant shall attend the concerned police station on every Sunday in between 10.00 AM to 12.00 PM.
5. Applicant shall not directly and indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts and circumstances of case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the police and Court.
6. Applicant shall co-operate in investigation and make himself available for investigation as and when required by the investigation officer.
7. Applicant shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
8. Applicant shall furnish his permanent and temporary residential proof, valid e-mail ID and mobile number to investigation officer.
9. Inform concerned police station, accordingly.
