**ORDER**

1. By this application, the applicant has prayed for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Crime No.34/2026 registered with Kharghar Police Station, Navi Mumbai for the offence punishable under Section 303(3), 318(4), 238(3) r/w 3(5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,

2. Ld. advocate Mr. Indrajeet Bhosale for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is in custody from 28/01/2026 and that material part of the investigation is over. According to him, the vehicle in question has also been recovered and therefore further detention of the applicant in the custody is not necessary. Therefore, he has prayed to grant the application.
3. Ld. APP Mr. A. S. Thakur for the State has submitted that after the arrest of the applicant and co-accused it is found that the applicant was also involved in other three crimes and that if the applicant is released on bail, he would repeat similar type of offence and therefore, he has prayed to reject the application.
4. Admittedly, the offence alleged against the applicant is tribal by the Ld. JMFC. It is also an admitted position that the vehicle in question has also been recovered. In the light of this I am of the view that further detention of the applicant in the custody is unwarranted.
5. So far as the apprehension shown by the Ld. APP that the applicant is likely to repeat similar type of crime is concerned, in my view if the applicant is directed to attend the office of the crime branch weekly till the trial is

concluded and if he is directed that he shall not involve in similar activities that would meet the ends of justice. Hence, I pass following order.

**:: ORDER ::**

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The applicant namely **Sanjeev Gangaram Saxsena** in Crime No.34/2026 registered with Kharghar Police Station, Navi Mumbai for the offence punishable under Section 303(3), 318(4), 238(3) r/w 3(5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, is ordered to be released on bail on his executing P. B. and S. B. of Rs.60,000/- in the like amount.
- 3) Applicant shall attend office of Crime Branch Central Unit, Belapur on every Monday between 10:00 AM to 12:00 noon till the trial is concluded.
- 4) If during pendency of the trial it is found that the applicant is involved in similar activities and that if he is arrested with similar accusation, in other crime, bail granted in his favour shall be treated as cancelled.
- 5) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly pressurize the informant and prosecution witnesses.
- 6) Applicant shall submit a list of at least 3 blood/nearest relatives with their detail residential addresses and also the addresses of their place of work, if any and documentary proof of showing the correctness of the details produced by them.
- 7) Applicant and the surety as a condition for grant of bail

must necessarily inform the police authorities as well as this Court change of their residential address, while applicant on bail.

- 8) Applicant shall submit copies of at least two documents amongst the Passport, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, Ration Card, Electricity bill or Voter Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India.
- 9) After submission of these two documents the concerned Police Station shall conduct physical verification of the residential address so as to confirm the address appearing on these documents and place before the Court a certificate to that effect under the signature of the S.H.O.
- 10) Applicant shall not misuse discretion which has been used by this court in his favour.
- 11) Bail before learned J.M.F.C.
- 12) Inform to concern Police Station and the applicant through Superintendent of prison.
