**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

1. By this application, the applicant, who is apprehending arrest, has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail under Section 482 of the BNSS in C. R. No.52/2026 registered with Kalamboli Police Station, Navi Mumbai for the offences punishable under Sections 333, 324 (2), 189 (2), 189 (4), 191 (2), 191 (3), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,

2023 and under Section 37(1)(3)/135 of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951.

2. Learned advocate Mr. Tushar Sondkar for the applicant has submitted that there is no direct allegations against the applicant except to mention that he was member of an unlawful assembly. According to him, applicant is ready to co-operate the Investigation Agency for the purpose of investigation. Thus, he has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail.
3. Learned A.P.P. Mr. A. S. Thakur has submitted that applicant was the member of an unlawful assembly and as such he is liable for the act of settled principle of the unlawful assembly. According to Mr. Thakur despite the notice under Section 35 of the BNSS was issued the applicant, did not co-operate the Investigation Officer. Thus, it is prayed for rejection of the application.
4. Upon perusal of the report dated 16/02/2026 lodged by Ajit Kundalik Bhanuse, it is found that the incident in question is output of an election. It is alleged that on 16/02/2026 at about 1.50 a.m. co-accused Kiran and Sumit have entered within the premises of Hansdhwani Society, Sector-15, Kalamboli, Tal-Panvel and that they have shown the knife or wooden log to the watchman and

others and that they have damaged the number plates of the car of the informant and the glasses were damaged.

5. Upon perusal of the report and reply filed by the Investigation Officer, it is found that there are allegations simple against the applicant that he was a member of an unlawful assembly. No doubt, if there is substance in the contention of the Investigation Officer that the applicant did not co-operate the Investigation Agency, in my view, if the applicant is directed to attend the police station and co-operate the Investigation Officer that would suffice the purpose. Hence, I proceed to pass following order;

**:: ORDER ::**

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) In the event of arrest, applicant **Navnath Rangnath Hulge** in Crime No.52/2026 registered with Kalamboli Police Station, Navi Mumbai for the offences punishable under Sections 333, 324(2),189(2), 189(4), 191(2), 191(3), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and under Section 37(1)(3)/135 of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951, is ordered to be released on bail on his executing P.B. and S. B. of Rs.15,000/- (Rs. Fifteen Thousand Only) in the like amount.
- 3) The applicant shall attend Kalamboli Police Station, Navi Mumbai on 14/03/2026, 16/03/2026 and 18/03/2026

between 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. and thereafter as and when required by the Investigation Officer by a written summons.

- 4) Needless to say that if the applicant does not extend co-operation to the Investigation Agency, the bail granted in their favour shall be liable to be cancelled.
- 5) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly pressurize the informant and prosecution witnesses.
- 6) Applicant shall submit a list of at least 3 blood/nearest relatives with their detail residential addresses and also the addresses of their place of work, if any and documentary proof of showing the correctness of the details produced by them.
- 7) Applicant and the surety as a condition for grant of bail must necessarily inform the police authorities as well as this Court, change of their residential address, while applicant on bail.
- 8) Applicant shall submit copies of at least two documents amongst the Passport, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, Ration Card, Electricity bill or Voter Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India.
- 9) After submission of these two documents the concerned Police Station shall conduct physical verification of the residential address so as to confirm the address appearing

on these documents and place before the Court a certificate to that effect under the signature of the S.H.O.

- 10) Applicant shall not misuse discretion which has been used by this court in his favour.
- 11) Inform to concern Police Station.
