ORDER BELOW EXH.102

1. By this application, the applicant/accused No.1 Mohamad Ikrar Kuddas Khan has prayed for grant of bail.
2. Learned advocate for the applicant has submitted that next date of hearing was not properly communicated to him, and due to his continuous travel outside station for truck driving duty, he was unaware of the said date and hence he could not attend the Court and therefore warrant was issued against him. He would submit that hereinafter the applicant would appear before the Court regularly. Therefore it is prayed for grant of bail.
3. Learned APP Mr. A. S. Thakur has submitted that the applicant has remained absent continuously and therefore the matter has prolonged due to his absence. According to Mr. Thakur, if the applicant is released on bail, he will not be available for facing trial and therefore he has prayed to reject the application.
4. Upon perusal of the record, it is found that the matter has protracted due to absence of the applicant. However,

considering the submission advanced by learned advocate for the applicant that the applicant would appear before this Court regularly and that he would see that the trial is proceeded further without fail, in my view it would be just to exercise discretion in favour of the applicant. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

- 1) The application Exh.102 is allowed.
- 2) The applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his executing P. B. and S. B. of Rs.50,000/- subject to penalty of Rs.5,000/-.
- 3) Applicant shall not directly or indirectly pressurize the informant and prosecution witnesses.
- 4) Applicant shall submit a list of at least 3 blood/nearest relatives with their detail residential addresses and also the addresses of their place of work, if any and documentary proof of showing the correctness of the details produced by them.
- 5) Applicant and the surety as a condition for grant of bail must necessarily inform the police authorities as well as this Court change of their residential address, while applicant on bail.
- 6) Applicant shall submit copies of at least two documents amongst the Passport, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, Ration Card, Electricity bill or Voter Identity Card issued by the Election Commission of India.
- 7) After submission of these two documents the concerned Police Station shall conduct physical verification of the residential address so as to confirm the address appearing on these documents and place before the Court a

certificate to that effect under the signature of the S.H.O.

- 8) Applicant shall not misuse discretion which has been used by this court in his favour.
- 9) Inform to concerned Police Station and the applicant through Superintendent of prison.
