ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.29 IN SESSIONS CASE NO.66/2025
(Dated 31/01/2026)

The applicant/accused Deepak Mohan Phad had preferred present application for interim bail on medical ground.

2] It is the case of applicant/accused that he is suffering from piles and having continuous bleeding and back pain. He took treatment from time to time in jail hospital. As there is no satisfactory progress in his health condition, the jail authority referred him to Civil Hospital, Panvel. He was admitted in the hospital from 11/12/2025 to 14/12/2025. The treating doctor opined that he may require surgery for his illness, if bleeding continuous. Further it is stated that continuously he is suffering from rectal bleeding, acute abdominal pain and severe constipation which cannot be managed through routine medication and it requires specialized medical and surgical intervention. Further it is stated by applicant/accused that conservative treatment is insufficient and delay in surgery may aggravate his condition and pose a serious risk to his health. The jail hospital does not have adequate facilities for specialized surgical treatment. Hence, it is prayed by applicant/accused that he be enlarged on interim/temporary bail for a period of two

months. He undertakes that he is ready to abide by the terms and conditions which may be imposed by the court.

3] The opponent State resisted the application by filing say at Exh.30. It is stated that the applicant is accused of serious offence. If he is released on bail, definitely he will jump the bail. The possibility of his bringing pressure on material witnesses cannot be ruled out. Hence, it is prayed that the application be rejected.

4] The report of Chief Medical Officer, Talaja Central Prison was called. Accordingly the CMO has submitted his report vide Exh.31.

5] Heard Ld. Adv. Smt. Komal Shinde for the applicant and Ld. APP Shri Y. S. Bhopi for opponent State. Perused application and material placed on record.

6] Both Ld. Advocates made their respective submissions on the line of averments made in the application and say respectively. After giving thoughtful consideration to their respective submissions, I have gone through the papers placed on record. The medical report submitted by the Chief Medical Officer, Talaja Central Prison clearly shows that, the applicant was having per rectal bleeding on and off with some times constipation. He was referred to NMMC Hospital, Vashi on 04/04/2025 and 25/11/2025 for back pain and per-rectal bleeding, where he was

examined and treated on OPD basis and referred to surgeon,. Then he was referred to surgical opinion to Sub-District Hospital, Panvel where he was admitted from 11/12/2025 to 14/12/2025 for his same complaints and he was given treatment by MD Physician and Surgeon. As per their advice, he may need surgery if rectal bleeding continuous and in that circumstances he will be referred to Sir J. J. Group of Hospital, Mumbai for further treatment. Taking into account the report submitted by Chief Medical Officer, Talaja Central Prison, Navi Mumbai, I do not find that the applicant/accused has made out case for interim/temporary bail. Hence, I am not inclined to grant temporary/interim bail to the applicant/ accused Deepak Phad. Resultantly, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The application stands rejected.
2. The jail authority is hereby directed to take due care of applicant/accused Deepak Mohan Phad for any health difficulties and take him to the doctor of jail authority and if required, refer him to the appropriate Government Hospital for medical treatment.
3. Inform the Superintendent of Talaja Central Prison, Navi Mumbai
