1. Heard.
2. This application is filed by prosecution for granting permission to collect blood samples of accused for DNA examination.
3. Say of accused was called upon. Accused has strongly objected the application.
4. Perused Record.
5. Ld. Spl. P. P submitted that FSL, Kalina has communicated to concerned police station that semen stains are found on clothes of victim and DNA profile is collected from it. To

6. compare it, DNA profile of accused is required which can be collected from the blood sample of the accused.
7. Ld. advocate for accused submitted that police authority has not taken blood samples before the medical officer and they have not acted as per law. They have exceeded valuable time of Court and prolonging the matter.
8. In present cases accused is facing charges for offences punishable u/s.137(2), 64(2), 65(1) of the BNS and u/s.4 & 8 of the POCSO Act. Clothes of victim & accused were seized. Clothes were sent for forensic analysis and FSL has communicated to concerned police station that semen stains are found on clothes of victim.
9. Concerned FSL has collected DNA Profile from semen stains and intends to compare it with DNA profile of present accused. Record further shows that penis swap, cubic hairs and nail clipping of accused were collected during his medical examination but his blood sample was not taken.
10. If the nature of offence is considered then offence is serious in nature and it is necessary to give proper opportunity to prosecution to produce the evidence to bring the guilt of accused. If provisions of the BNSS, 2023 as well as necessity of investigation is considered then I am of the view that there is no hurdle to grant such permission to the prosecution and accused can be directed to give blood samples for extracting DNA profile. As a result, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application are allowed.
2. Permission is granted to Panvel Railway Station to take blood samples of the accused after making necessary correspondence to jail authority in which accused is inmate.
3. Accused is directed to co-operate in same.

(Application is disposed of accordingly)
